## Education

Joint Development International's response in Afghanistan has initially concentrated on relief and rehabilitation efforts, helping to restore the lives of families returning from refugee or internally displaced camps. Many of these families have not had the opportunity to educate their children. Through the efforts of JDA, new schools are being built providing communities with educational facilities. Nine out of ten women are illiterate and education for girls has become an important issue. We have been working in over 200 villages and the main question we are asked is, "Will you help us build a school for our children?"

Communities have come together to help in the construction, providing their own labor and contributing local expertise. The greatest resource Afghanistan has is its people and they know that education for their children is vital for lasting change. Afghanistan has within itself the resources to develop in all areas and we in JDA continue to be a catalyst in implementing change.
